


Water plays a vital role in shaping our cities, yet urban life has distanced us from its natural flow. The Łódź Pilot is exploring how art and sustainability can bring people closer to water through "The Freedom Flow. Be Like Water" project that focuses on designing the system for water filtration and slow rainwater runoff. Developed in collaboration with artist Mona El Batrik, the project tries to merge traditional ceramic filtration techniques with mycofiltration and other natural materials to create an interactive and evolving water system. The initiative goes beyond design, aiming to spark conversations on water management and environmental awareness through co-creation with the local community.


